

## **Comtech Telecommunications Corp. Receives \$1.2 Million Task Order on IDIQ Contract for Plug-and-Play Microsatellites**

**Melville, NY, October 6, 2010** – Comtech Telecommunications Corp. (NASDAQ:CMTL) announced today that its Virginia-based subsidiary, Comtech AeroAstro, Inc., has been awarded a \$1.2 million order, Task Order 3, from the Air Force Research Laboratory (“AFRL”) for Plug-and-Play Network CDR level design, test, and integration. This is the third task order awarded to Comtech AeroAstro under the Advanced Plug-and-Play Technologies indefinite delivery/indefinite quantity (“IDIQ”) contract, bringing the total awarded to \$1.9 million. The contract has a maximum value of \$200.0 million.

“Plug-and-play technologies are changing the paradigm for space mission development,” said Fred Kornberg, President and Chief Executive Officer of Comtech Telecommunications Corp. “This contract enables us to finalize the design, test, and integration of the onboard spacecraft network with a high fidelity spacecraft simulator, enabling realistic flight environment testing across all spacecraft systems and subsystems. This task order puts us in strong contention to develop the nation’s first full plug-and-play satellite.”

Mr. Kornberg added, “This award represents further evidence that our investment in our microsatellite product line is resulting in new contract awards and growth opportunities. We continue to solidify our position as a source for innovative mission solutions, as the U.S. government looks for lower-cost alternatives to achieving their goals in space.”
